February 1, 1930 - April 25, 2009

Mr. Austin Langley, age 79 of Fairview Road, Calhoun, passed away Saturday, April 25, 2009 at Floyd Medical Center. He was born on February 1, 1930 in Gordon County; son of the late Chess and Stella Carroll Langley.
