Rev. Willie Boyd (Bob) Johnson, age 79 of Calhoun, passed away Sunday, July 6, 2008 at Gordon Hospital.

Rev. Johnson was born on November 6, 1928 in Tifton, GA, son of the late Samuel O. Johnston and Icy Young Johnston. He was also preceded in death by his wife, Geraldine Patterson Johnson, and a son, Rodney Johnson.

During his lifetime, Rev. Johnson served as pastor of Antioch Baptist Church and the Hopewell Baptist Church. He was a member of South Calhoun Baptist Church and was retired from the textile industry.
