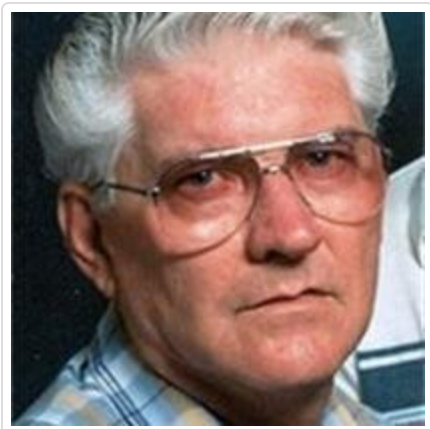




Butch Bryant

January 20, 1933 - June 10, 2009

Mr. Ernest Lionel "Butch" Bryant, age 76 of Calhoun, died Wednesday, June 10, 2009 at his residence following an extended illness. Mr. Bryant was born in Floyd county January 20, 1933, son of the late Rosco and Ethel Hartline Bryant. He was a retired textile maintenance worker at Crown Craft for 20 years, and served in the United States Navy from 1951 - 1955.
