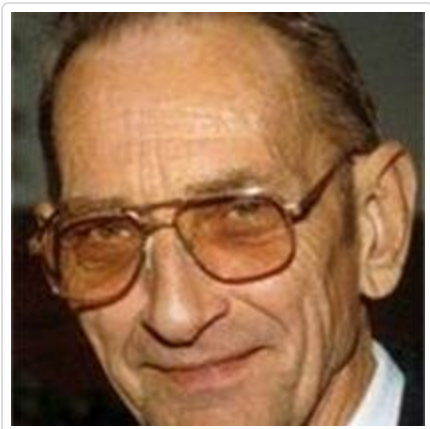




Charles McCormick
