Mr. Clinton Leroy Stephens, age 59 of Calhoun, died Wednesday, March 9, 2011 at Gordon Hospital following a brief illness.

He was born on January 9, 1952 in Laurinburg, North Carolina, son of the late Robert Louis Stephens and the late Pearlle Abragray Sellers Furnish. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by a sister, Rose Marie Rault. Mr. Stephens was a veteran, serving his country with the United States Army during the Vietnam era.
