



## C.M. Harrison

October 10, 1928 - January 6, 2013

Mr. C.M. Harrison, age 84 of Sugar Valley, GA passed away Sunday, January 6, 2013 at Gordon Hospital. He was born in Whitfield County on October 10, 1928, son of the late Gorge W.
