March 30, 1917 - June 5, 2010

Mrs. Cora Pauline Waggoner, age 93 of the Hall Memorial Community, Calhoun, passed away Friday, June 4, 2010 at Gordon Hospital following several months of declining health.

Mrs. Waggoner was born on March 30, 1917 in Hamilton County, daughter of the late James L. and Janie Rebecca Wilson Powers.
