December 9, 1921 - December 18, 2010

Mr. David Thomas Childers age 89 of Calhoun, died Saturday December 18, 2010 in Gordon Hospital following several months declining health.

Mr. Childers was born in Pickens County, Georgia on December 9, 1921, son of the late Walter and Seenie Fox Childers. He had lived the greater part of his life in Pickens County except for his tenure in the United States Army, having served in World War II. He was the recipient of two Purple Heart Medals from wounds he received in France in 1944, along with other various commendations.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Velva Macabee Childers; a son, Ricky Childers; a sister, Mary Garrison; and a brother, Charlie Childers.

Survivors include four sons; Travis Childers and his wife Judy of Calhoun, Chris Childers and his wife Cleo of Calhoun, Gary Childers and his wife Dianne of Jasper and Donnie Childers and his wife Tina of Calhoun. Three brothers; Ham Childers and his wife Linda of Jasper, J.W. Childers and his wife Betty of Jasper and William Childers of Jasper.
