Mr. David Larry Page, 62, of Winston-Salem, NC passed away Friday, October 5, 2012 at his home.

He was born January 15, 1950 in Fort McPherson, Georgia to Mary Walden Page and the late William Curtis Page, Sr. Mr. Page was employed by Hanesbrands for 31 years. He was an active member of College Park Baptist Church. His love for sports led him to spend many years coaching in the Winston-Salem Optimist soccer league, West Central Community Center basketball league, Pop Warner football - Mount Tabor Falcons, and the Pilot Mountain Association basketball league.
