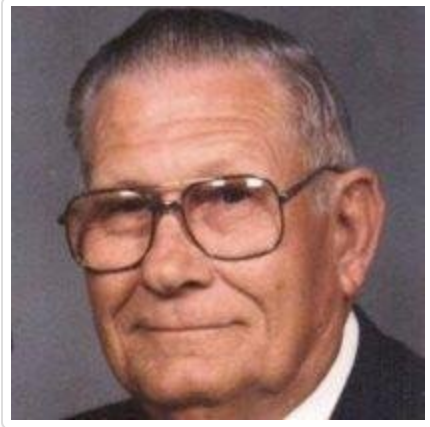




Mr. Ervin Wilford Greeson

January 16, 1931 - February 6, 2014

Mr. Ervin Wilford Greeson, age 83 of Resaca, passed away Thursday, February 6, 2014 at his residence. He was born on January 16, 1931 in Whitfield County to the late Claude Alexander Greeson and the late Lou Ella Barton Greeson. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by brothers, Baxter Greeson, Wilburn Greeson, Benson Greeson, Leon Greeson, and C.W. Greeson; and sisters, Lillie Ray, Mary Sue Talley, and Lois Johnson.

During his lifetime, Mr. Greeson was a veteran, serving his country in the US Air Force during the Korean Conflict, and had been employed with Hiawassee Land Company.
