



## Freeman Seritt

October 6, 1916 - November 13, 2007

Mr. Freeman Offit Seritt, age 91, of Shannon, Georgia passed away November 13, 2007 at Erlanger Medical Center following a short illness. He was born October 6, 1916 in Floyd County, son of the late Wylie and Susan Jenette Seritt.

Mr. Seritt was preceded in death by his first wife, Lillie Maude Cleary Seritt, and two of his sons, William G. (Janice) Seritt, and Freddie L. Seritt as well as his siblings, Reece, Cleave, and Jack Seritt and Gaude Pettit.

He served in the South Pacific during World War II and lived and worked in North Georgia almost all of his life. He loved his family and liked nothing better than to have them all gather around. The latest gathering was on his 91st birthday, October 6, 2007 when he had a great time visiting with everyone and riding his motorized scooter. He was known as "Cut" by his brickyard friends (he always cut down his vehicles to become trucks). We fondly remember his love of gospel music, gardening and tinkering with things. He continued to work with scrap metal almost until the end. These endeavors and his family kept him going. Devoted husband, father, and "Pawpaw", lives in us all and will always be remembered with love and affection.
