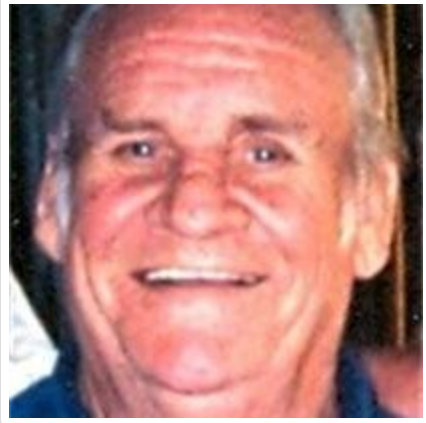




George Stone

Mr. George Farris Stone, age 69 of Ranger, Georgia, passed away Thursday, April 23, 2009 at Floyd Medical Center in Rome following an extended illness.
