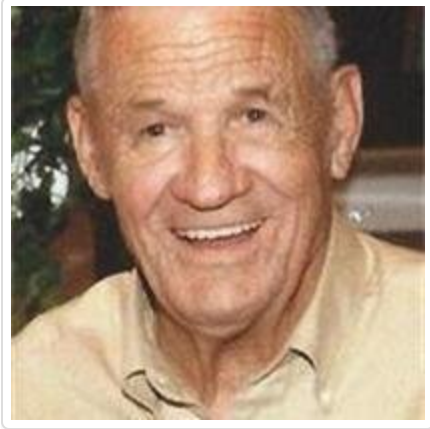




Howard Patterson
