Mr. Joe Kilpatrick age 62 of Calhoun, died Thursday October 4, 2012 at Floyd Medical Center in Rome.

Joe was affectionately known by his family as "Paw-Paw". He was born in Cleveland, Tennessee on October 31, 1949, son of the late Earl and Willie Mae Johnson Kilpatrick.
