Mr. John Dale (Buddy) Pasley, age 73 of Resaca, Georgia, died Wednesday, June 06, 2007 at Gordon Hospital.

Buddy (whom everyone knew him as) was born on May 10, 1934 in Bartow County, son of the late Joseph Dennard Pasley and Esther Winnie Cooper Pasley. Besides his parents, he was preceded in death by brothers; Gordon W. Pasley in 1963, Harold D. (Spot) Pasley in 1988, Doyle Pasley in 1997 and James L. Pasley in 2002.
