June 16, 1943 - April 30, 2009

Mrs. Katheryn Sims Dodd, age 65 of the New Town Community, Calhoun, passed away Thursday, April 30, 2009 at her residence following two years of declining health.

Mrs. Dodd was born on June 16, 1943 in Bartow County, daughter of the late Floyd and Willie Garrett Sims. In addition to her parents, she was also preceded in death by a sister, Patsy Ray.
