Mrs. Kathleen Dillard Moore Conaway, age 95 of Plainville, died Thursday March 27, 2014 at her residence following a brief illness.

Kathleen was born in Plainville on October 21, 1918, daughter of the late John Dillard and Mae Bagley Dillard.
