January 5, 1945 - February 9, 2014

Mr. Lamar Sosebee, age 69 of Resaca, GA passed away Sunday, February 9, 2014 at Gordon Hospital. He was born in Whitfield County on January 5, 1945, son of the late Atticus and Hester McKeehan Sosebee.
