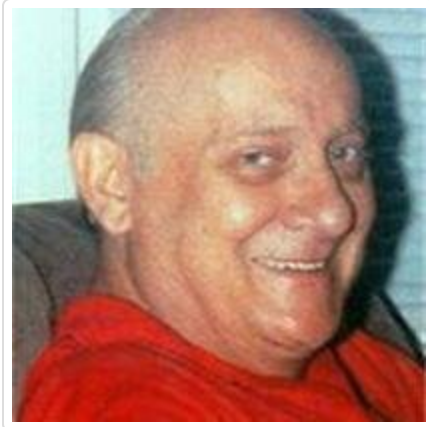




Lewis Evans
