January 12, 1916 - September 22, 2007

Mrs. Louise Morgan Evans, age 91 of Calhoun, died Saturday September 22, 2007 in Gordon Health Care, after two years declining health.

Mrs. Evans was born in Cedar Bluff, Alabama on January 12, 1916, daughter of the late James H. Morgan and Beulah Nowlin Morgan.
