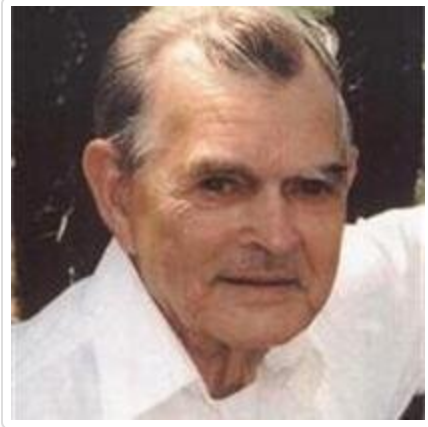




## Murray Johnson,
