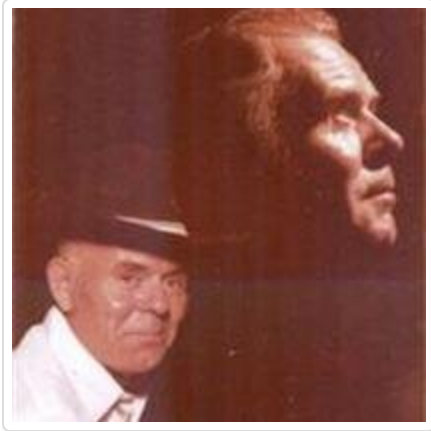




Ned VanDyke
