May 31, 1931 - October 31, 2012

Mr. Ralph Wyatt, age 81 of Resaca, GA passed away Wednesday, October 31, 2012 at his residence following several months of declining health. He was born in Gordon County on May 31, 1931, son of the late John Staton Wyatt and the late Martha Cherry Wyatt. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by four brothers, Claude, Howard, L.D., and Bill Wyatt; and a sister, Pauline W. Tatum.

Mr. Wyatt was a 1950 graduate of Fairmount High School, and a retired poultry farmer. He was a member of the Sugar Valley Masonic Lodge #733 F &AM, and was past Master. He was past Master of the Resaca Lodge #724 F&AM in 1980-81, and was Master of the Gordon Masonic Convention in 1998. He was a member of the Gordon County Masonic Memorial.

Survivors include his wife of 53 years, Beulah Mae Davidson Wyatt; a step-son, Clarence Smith and his wife Connie of Ft. Worth, TX; a brother, Hank Wyatt of Plainville; and special friends, Rev. Joe and Alisha Parker and daughter Melea of Resaca.
