Mr. R.M. Greeson, age 82 of Calhoun, died Sunday, May 15, 2011 at Gordon Hospital following nine months of declining health. He was a native of Gordon County, born on February 28, 1929 to the late Luke and Aline Jones Greeson. Mr. Greeson was a veteran, serving his country in the US Army during the Korean conflict.
