Mr. Robert M. Goble, Sr., age 87 of Calhoun, Georgia, passed away Saturday afternoon, June 09, 2007.

Mr. Goble was born on July 13, 1919 in Gilmer County, Georgia, son of the late William Goble and Sally Simmons Goble. He was also preceded in death by his wife, Dessie Stansell Goble on June 01, 2003. Mr. Goble proudly served his country with the United States Army during World War II, and was a decorated veteran earning the American Theater Ribbon, Eamet Service Medal, Good Conduct Medal and the World War II Victory Medal. Following the end of the war, he returned home where he became employed as a carpenter. He was a member and Deacon of Hall Memorial Baptist Church. Mr. Goble is survived by one son; Robert Goble Jr. and his wife Teena of Dallas, Texas; two granddaughters; Stephanie Goble and Amy Goble, both of Dallas. Several nieces and nephews also survive.
