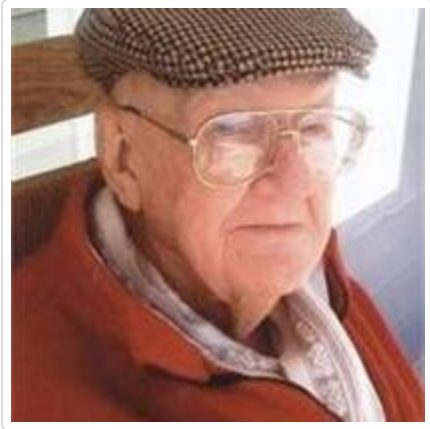




Vincent Evans

January 18, 1923 - June 23, 2011

Mr. Vincent Evans, age 88 of Calhoun, died Thursday, June 23, 2011 at Calhoun Health Care Center following a brief illness. Mr. Evans was born on January 18, 1923 in Bartow County, Georgia, son of the late Vince Evans, Sr. and Martha Clyde Chitwood Evans.
