January 27, 1915 - August 8, 2008

Mr. William Mitchell Bowman, age 93 of Resaca, passed away Friday morning, August 8, 2008 at his residence, following a year of declining health. Mr. Bowman was born on January 27, 1915 in Rockmart, son of the late William Mitchell Bowman and Willie Jean Bowman. He was a veteran of the United States Coast Guard, having served from 1933 until 1939. He was preceded in death by his wife, Mae Belle Morgan Bowman, to whom he had been married for 59 years.
