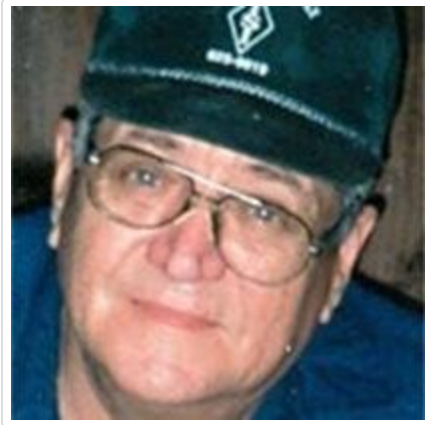




William Franklin
