Sgt. Winston David Evans, age 67 of Resaca, passed away Wednesday, October 21st, 2009 at Murray County Hospital.

He was born on April 10th, 1942 in Gordon County, son of Wilma Goodnight Evans and the late Asa David Evans. In addition to his father, he was also preceded in death by his wife, Dorothy Jean Langley Evans, a daughter, Sabrina Nation, and a son, David Evans. Sgt.
